### NANPA Showcase Competition Terms of Use:

#### DEFINITIONS:

1. "NANPA" collectively refers to the North American Nature Photography Association and the NANPA Foundation.
2. "Photographer" refers to the NANPA member submitting images and his or her heirs and assigns.
3. "Period of Two Years" refers to a date two years after the date the Showcase winners are publicly announced.
4. "Winning Images" refers to the top 250 Showcase images, as judged by the Showcase judges.

#### AGREED TERMS:

1. Photographer retains copyright and ownership of all images submitted to the Showcase, subject to the agreed licenses as set forth herein.
2. Photographer grants NANPA a license to use Winning Images for the promotion and advertising purposes of NANPA, including NANPA events, ads in major photography magazines, membership communications, NANPA blogs and social media, and other uses that further the NANPA mission.
3. Photographer further grants NANPA a license to use Winning Images on NANPA websites in image slideshows and portfolios. The intent is to highlight the top images from each year's Showcase, including past Showcases (e.g. 2020 Showcase, 2021 Showcase, 2022 Showcase etc., or subsets thereof). After a Period of Two Years, Photographer may revoke this license by sending NANPA an email to [info@nanpa.org](mailto:info@nanpa.org) explicitly listing the Winning Images Photographer wants removed. Upon revocation, NANPA will take reasonable steps to remove such images on any NANPA websites.
4. Consistent with NANPA's Internet and [Social Media Policy](#), any images posted to a NANPA blog or social media cannot subsequently be removed.
5. NANPA will make reasonable efforts to include a copyright/credit line supplied by the Photographer on every usage.
6. NANPA will make reasonable efforts to notify Photographer by email prior to publication about when and how their image will be used.
7. NANPA reserves the right to crop and reorient any photograph for design or editorial purposes. Every effort will be made to maintain the original integrity and intent of the image.
