Membership Categories:

General Member - Membership is open to amateur and professional photographers, industry specialists, nature lovers, educators, photo agents, editors - anyone interested in photography of our environment. Membership includes full voting privileges, NANPA's webinar program, access to the annual Showcase photo competition, discounts for regional events and Summits, access to the membership directory for networking purposes, discounts on equipment and business insurance as well as products and services of interest to nature photographers, and many other benefits.
